On A4117, at the Three Horseshoes public house at the Western end of Cleobury Mortimer turn into Childe Road, signposted "Sports Centre" and "Lacon Childe School". Turn left at mini-roundabout into Love Lane. Lacon Childe School is about 100 yards on the left. There are two car parks. There is a second, larger, car park just after the main entrance. Changing rooms are at the back of the school, accessible from the second car park. HQ is accessible off the first (school dining room).

Numbers and signing on sheet will be at the Headquarters. Allow about 15 minutes to get to the start. Refreshments will be on sale after the event.

## Get to the Start from HQ:

Return to Cleobury town via Love Lane and Childe Road. Turn left on A4117 through town. Just outside the town turn left on the B4363, signposted Bridgnorth. Continue to start in the turning for the Industrial Estate approx. 1 mile from the junction.

### Course:

Start on B4363 approximately 1½ miles NE of Cleobury Mortimer at Give Way from Old Station industrial estate. Follow B4363 towards Bridgnorth for 11 miles via Kinlet and Billingsley. Turn left 500 yards after Half Way House Inn signed Morville 3. Continue for ¾ mile to B4364 and turn left. Follow B4364 for 15½ miles via Neenton, Cleobury North and Burwarton to junction with A4117. Left on A4117 via Clee Hill to Cleobury Mortimer. Finish at layby 150 yards beyond 40 sign at first repeater 40 sign.

### Distances:

- Cape of Good Hope Inn, Billingsley 6.11
- Left turn towards Morville 11.12
- Left turn on B4364 11.89
- Bend right at Neenton Church 16.84
- Brown Clee summit beyond three Horseshoes 21.80
- Left turn on A4117 27.58
- Cattle grid at east end of Clee Hill village 31.67
- Finish entering Cleobury Mortimer 36.59

## Course Profile

### Climbs:

- Low point near Bridgnorth 220 feet
- Brown Clee Summit 1090 feet (870 feet climb)
- Low point near B4364 and A4117 junction 370 feet
- Summit of Clee Hill 1250 feet (880 feet climb), includes 300m of 10-15%

## Hazards:

- Several narrow bridges with bends on section towards Bridgnorth. One of these has rider priority but still needs care.
- Left turn on to B4364 has limited visibility.
- Poor road surfaces and badly placed metal covers on parts of B4364.
- Just before Neenton, a narrow bridge has priority against rider. CARE
- Cattle grids at Clee Hill and Doddington (before descent to Hopton) are very jarring even at low speeds.
- Beware of sheep on the descent of Clee Hill, i.e. between the two cattle grids.
- Bend right at foot of Hopton Bank after very fast 15% descent.
